HOTEL DU PARC POITIERS

Description: Friendly, 1-star hotel.

Location: 8 minutes walk from Futuroscope.

Capacity: 669

Rooms for pupils: Mostly 5 beds; all with shower/WC and TV.

Facilities: Foyer with drinks/snack machines. Games and pool table at Les Pirates.

Meals: Continental breakfast and evening meals (all-you-can-eat buffet) are taken at the nearby Les Pirates restaurant. Lunch on the first day of your visit is taken at a cafeteria or fast-food restaurant in Futuroscope.

Description: Comfortable, 2-star hotel.

Location: 8 minutes walk from Futuroscope.

Capacity: 425
