RHINE VALLEY CITIES

Bonn Old Town

Bonn: Known as the “Gateway to the Romantic Rhine”, Bonn is an attractive and cultural city with an interesting history dating back over 2000 years. The top class museums of Bonn’s “Museum Mile” include the distinctive Art and Exhibition Hall, the House of the History of the Federal Republic of Germany and the Museum of Modern Art. A tour of the Beethoven House, birthplace of Ludwig van Beethoven, the world famous composer, is a must-see for all visitors to this inviting city.



Koblenz

Germany’s most beautiful “corner”. This 2000-year old town, situated in the picturesque landscape of the Rhine and Moselle is surrounded by four low mountain ranges. The view from the Ehrenbreitstein fortress high above the Rhine across the river down to “Deutsches Eck” with its re-erected equestrian statue of Emperor William I, is spectacular. An abundance of cultural monuments and historic buildings together with pretty lanes and bustling squares make Koblenz a relaxed and friendly town to visit.

BONN Jugendherberge Bonn


Description: Comfortable, friendly youth hostel

Location: Bonn-Venusberg on the edge of the Kottenforst Nature Park

Capacity: 249

Rooms for pupils: 2-4 beds; all with shower and WC

Facilities: TV room, relaxation lounge, games room, table-tennis (indoor and outdoor), large garden terrace. Well equipped meeting rooms (supplement payable).



KOBLENZ Jugendherberge Festung Ehrenbreitstein

Description: Newly-built youth hostel with excellent facilities

Location: The hostel is located in the southern part of Ehrenbreitstein fortress, with views of the Rhine and Moselle valleys, the City and the “Deutsches Eck”

Capacity: 157 beds

Rooms for pupils: Mostly 2-4 beds; all with shower and WC

Facilities: Café-bar, bistro, restaurant, snack-area, internet terminal, indoor games and table-tennis. Well equipped relaxation/meeting rooms of various sizes. Ample space outdoors for games. Barbecue area.
