

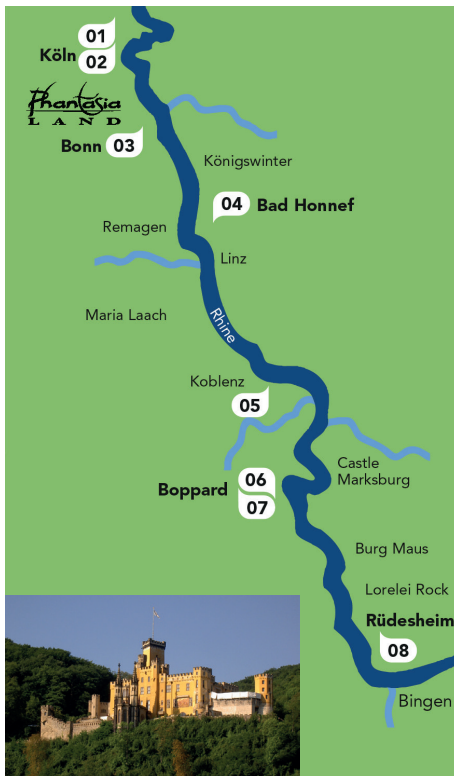
GERMANY RHINE VALLEY INTRODUCTION

Highlights include:

- Köln:** cosmopolitan city, famous for its magnificent Gothic cathedral
- Bonn:** university city and the birthplace of Ludwig van Beethoven
- Königswinter:** take a ride on the Drachenfels funicular railway and visit Schloss Drachenburg
- Linz:** historic old town with its famous castle
- Maria Laach Abbey:** a masterpiece of Romanesque architecture
- Remagen Bridge Peace Museum:** the only bridge to be left intact at the end of the Second World War
- Koblenz:** Stolzenfels Castle, Deutsches Eck and Ehrenbreitstein fortress
- Castle Marksburg:** the only hilltop castle on the Rhine never to have been destroyed
- Burg Maus:** now a falconry centre offering eagle and falcon flying displays
- Lorelei Rock:** steeped in legend and folklore
- Rheinfels Castle:** St. Goar, the most extensive castle ruins on the Rhine
- Bingen:** with its unusual Mäuseturm, a stone tower on a small island in the Rhine
